## **CCPA Privacy Notice**

Last Updated January 1, 2020

## **Legal Entities**

This California Consumer Privacy Act Privacy Notice ("CCPA Notice") supplements Quick Bridge Funding, LLC's Privacy Notice and Quick Bridge Funding LLC's <u>online Privacy Policies</u> (collectively, "Privacy Policies"). The term Quick Bridge Funding, LLC (collectively, "Quick Bridge Funding", "we", "us", or "our") in this CCPA Notice refer to any affiliates or subsidiaries of Quick Bridge Funding, LLC that link to this CCPA Notice.

### **Introduction and Applicability**

Your privacy is important to us. This CCPA Notice explains how we collect, use, share, and disclose personal information about **California residents** covered by the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 ("CCPA"). This notice explains how California residents can exercise their rights under the CCPA to request that we: (1) provide certain personal information that we have collected about them during the past 12 months, along with related information described below, (2) delete certain personal information that we have collected from them, or (3) opt consumers out of the sale of certain personal information.

This CCPA Notice uses certain terms that have the meaning given to them in the CCPA. Under the CCPA, "personal information" is information that identifies, relates to, or could reasonable be linked with a particular California resident or household.

Personal information does not include the following:

- Publicly available information from government records.
- Deidentified or aggregated consumer information.

With a limited exception, and as noted in other sections of this CCPA Notice, certain provisions of the CCPA do not apply to:

- Certain personal information covered by or collected under industry-specific privacy laws including, but not limited to, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996, the California Confidentiality of Medical Information Act, the Fair Credit Reporting Act, the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, the California Financial Information Privacy Act, and the Driver's Privacy Protection Act of 1994.
- Personal information that we collect about you when you are acting as our job applicant, employee, owner, director, officer, medical staff member, or contractor to the extent that we collect and use your personal information solely within the context of that role. This also includes your emergency contact information and personal information that is necessary for us to retain to administer benefits for you. However, you will still receive a notice at the time of collection which outlines the categories of personal information we collect and the purposes for which we collect the categories of personal information. Additional CCPA employment-related disclosure(s) supplement

- this CCPA Notice and will provide you with information on the personal information we collect, use and disclose specific to the job application and employment context, respectively.
- Personal information we receive from you reflecting a communication or transaction between us and another business when you are acting as an employee, owner, director, officer, or contractor of such company, partnership, sole proprietorship, nonprofit, or government agency and you are seeking a product or service from us for the company, partnership, sole proprietorship, nonprofit, or government agency (a "Business Consumer"). Where applicable, we have outlined the limited rights afforded to Business Consumers below.

## c. Sale of Personal Information

We may allow certain third parties (such as online web analytic services) to collect your personal information via automated technologies on our websites such as to provide personalized pages for visitors and provide assistance during the website visit. You have the right to opt out of this disclosure of your information, as detailed below.

During the 12-month period prior to the Last Updated date of this CCPA Notice, we may have sold the following categories of personal information:

- Identifiers such as a unique personal identifier (such as a device identifier; cookies, beacons, pixel tags, mobile ad identifiers and similar technology), online identifier, and Internet Protocol ("IP") address
- Commercial information, including records of personal property, products or services considered, and other purchasing or consuming histories or tendencies
- Internet and other electronic network activity information, including, but not limited to, browsing history, search history, and information regarding your interaction with websites, applications or advertisements
- Inferences drawn from any of the information identified above to create a profile about you reflecting your preferences, characteristics, psychological trends, predispositions, behavior, attitudes, intelligence, abilities, and aptitudes

We do not sell the personal information of minors under 16 years of age without affirmative authorization if we have actual knowledge of the individual's age.

### d. Disclosure of Personal Information for a Business Purpose

We may have disclosed to third parties the following categories of personal information for a business purpose:

### 3. California Consumer Privacy Rights

You have certain choices regarding your personal information, as described below.

**Right to Know/Access:** You have the right to send us a verifiable request, twice in a 12-month period, asking that we disclose to you the personal information we have collected, used, disclosed and sold about you during the past 12 months. **This right does not apply to Business Consumers, current or former employees, and job applicants.** 

For security purposes, there is certain information that we will not disclose to you. This information includes, but is not limited to, your Social Security number, driver's license number or other government-issued identification number, financial account number, and any health insurance or medical identification number.

**Right to Request Deletion:** You have the right to submit a verifiable request asking that we delete certain personal information we have collected from you. **This right does not apply to Business Consumers, current or former employees, and job applicants.** 

**Right to Opt-Out of Sale:** You have the right to opt-out of the sale of your personal information to third parties. This right does not apply to exceptions listed under the section above titled **Introduction and Applicability**, those subject to Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.45, or others subject to applicable law.

If you would like to opt-out of the sale of your personal information associated with a different device or browser, please submit an opt-out request using that device or browser. Please note that if you clear your cookies on a particular browser or device, you may need to resubmit your opt-out request again from that device or browser.

Verifying Requests. To help protect your privacy and maintain security, we will take steps to verify your identity before granting you access to your personal information or complying with your request. If you request access to or deletion of your personal information, we will require you to provide certain information, including but not limited to, your name, address, date of birth, email address, telephone number, or other identifiable information. In addition, we will require you to complete and sign a declaration under penalty of perjury that you are the consumer whose personal information is the subject of the request. If you designate an authorized agent to make an access, deletion or opt-out of sale request on your behalf (a) we will require you to provide the authorized agent written permission to do so, and (b) will require you to verify your own identity directly with us (as described above). In response to verified requests, we will confirm receipt of the request within 10 business days of receipt of the request, and disclose and deliver the required information to you free of charge within 45 days of receiving a verifiable consumer request. We may extend this time period to provide once by an additional 45 days when reasonably necessary. We will provide notice of the extension within the first 45-day period, including the reason(s) for the delay.

**Additional Information.** If you choose to exercise any of your rights under the CCPA, you have the right to not receive discriminatory treatment by us. We will not discriminate against you because you elect to exercise these rights, including by:

- Denying goods or services to you
- Charging you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through the use of discounts or other benefits or imposing penalties
- Providing a different level or quality of goods or services to you
- Suggesting that you will receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level of goods or services
